### **NEW PLEDGE NUMBERS**

By now the majority of our parishioners have been allocated with new pledge numbers and are using them - when pledging. There are however quite a number of parishioners who are still using their old pledge numbers. We encourage all to please convert to the new number system.

CHILDREN who over the age of 18 years should have their own pledge number. IF children are married and still living with their parents they SHOULD have their own pledge number. Parents should also encourage children to pledge at the young age.

PLEASE complete a REGISTRATION form to get your new pledge number as our new PLEDGE DATABASE system is fully operational.

### USAGE OF ALCOHOL ON CHURCH PREMISES

A directive from the last Provincial Synod of the Anglican Church of Southern Africa states that Parishes should be very circumspect with regards the usage of alcohol on its premises. When alcohol is not used responsibly, it can cause all sorts of social problems and as a caring church we must guard against this. Parish Council on 30 November resolved that with immediate effect to ban the usage of alcohol on Parish properties. This means that all future functions in the Parish Hall as well as future Parish Bazaars will be alcohol free. Functions where alcohol is to be consumed should be held offsite - at another venue.

#### PARISH PLANNING WORKSHOP

A very successful planning workshop was held on 28 November with 60 representatives from Organisations, Areas and Ministries participating. The workshop was held in a very good spirit and was very interactive. Although we were not able to complete the amendment of the Strategic plan due to time constraints, were able to do a full review of the plan. The next step is to take all of the points raised and combine them with the Vision and Mission of the Parish and amend the Strategic Plan accordingly. It was agreed that with the amendment, we should move our focus from 2020 to 2025. A follow-up meeting will be held early in the New Year to complete the Plan.
