THE EASTER STORY



Easter is the Sunday that celebrates the resurrection of Christ and is one of the most holiest days on the calendar of Christian churches. The Easter message is one of hope and victory over death, for it recalls that Christ rose from the dead on the third day after his crucifixion.

In many languages, the name Easter comes from the Hebrew word "pesah" or Passover. In fact Easter was first associated with the Hebrew festival of the Passover which falls in the spring. Easter was celebrated at different times by the early Christians until 325 A.D. when the council of Nicaea fixed the date as the first Sunday after the first full moon after March 21. This always places Easter to fall near the time of a full moon so that pilgrims journeying to worship a shrine might have moonlight to help them find their way.

The Glorious message of Easter

"He is not here, for He is risen" is the glorious message of Easter and the empty tomb. The Easter message is not an argument; it is a divine proclamation. The empty tomb speaks with a shout that

Jesus is alive!
